The essence of self-esteem is not knowledge of facts or possession of particular skills, rather, it is an attitude toward the self and it grows in childhood as a child experiences that he or she is valued. Although self-esteem is defined simply, it is connected to two separate areas within a child and both are critical to healthy selfesteem. Come learn what these two areas are & activities that promote good self-esteem in infant, toddler, & preschool children.

### **Recalls & Safety**

There have been a large number of crib and bassinet recalls over the past few months, so we want providers to be aware of the danger they pose and exercise caution. While we are required to do monthly crib inspections and annual checks with the Consumer Product Safety Commission, they have a nifty e-mail notification system to alert you of any recalls. You can choose all

product categories or just toys or baby items. I only receive an e-mail or two each week from them, but I am surprised at the things getting recalled, such as tools, light fixtures, clothing, toys, cribs, mattresses, and more. ### Tips and Tricks

#### Save money on utilities!

From our last training with Sandy Schroeder, if you haven't already, apply for a free federal EIN at <a href="http://www.irs.gov/businesses/small/article/0">http://www.irs.gov/businesses/small/article/0</a>, id=98350,00.html. That way you won't have to give out your private social security number on parent's receipts at the end of the year. Using

your EIN, you can then call your utility companies, such as XCel Energy, and ask if they have discounted rates for small businesses. Some companies such as Waste Management offer a discount if you pay in advance.
